



## Third Crossing Project Community Engagement Report: 2019

### Highlights from 2019

The information below highlights some of the project team's outreach and public engagement activities throughout 2019 with the broad community as well as with key stakeholders and community groups.

- The project team has held 35 community and stakeholder meetings meeting with over 700 people throughout 2019
- Held two open houses for the environmental considerations of the Detailed Impact Assessment for federal and provincial permits for in-water construction
- Released nine news releases, hand delivered 16 different notifications to community organizations advising up upcoming work and sent out eleven listservs to east and west near neighbour residents
- Sixteen e-newsletters have been issued to the more than 970 informing residents about upcoming work, in-water construction, work hours, council report, how to connect with the team, upcoming meetings and other information when necessary
- In regards to media, the project team has conducted 23 media interviews and there have been 45 articles reporting on or discussing the project
- Over 20,000 visits to the Third Crossing website with the top pages being the home page, project engagement and about construction
- Received and responded to 418 emails from residents from the Third Crossing dedicated email address
