Highlights from the last three months: September 2018 – December 2018

- The Third Crossing project team has had over ten community meetings and presentations meeting with over three hundred people
- The project team has issued six e-newsletters to subscribers letting people know of project updates, community meetings and other activities related to project activity. Over six hundred people have signed up for the e-newsletter
- [Three videos have been released](#) showcasing the awarded contract to build and do the detailed design of the bridge, information regarding early work activity for the bridge and proposed plans for the east and west shores of the bridge. The videos have received over fourteen thousand views
