



## Third Crossing Project Community Report

January 1, 2019 - January 31, 2019

### February updates

- Since September 2018, the project team has had 15 meetings with over 470 residents, ranging from 2 to 150 people in a room
- There have been over 40 media articles entirely covering or mentioning the Third Crossing in the last four months

### Community Meetings & Events

1. **February 11:** Project staff hosted a west-side near-neighbour meeting to discuss the latest site work and to be able to ask questions of the project team
  - About 30 people attended the meeting
  - Staff gave a brief presentation on laydown areas, early work continuing into 2019, noise mitigation, site safety, demolition of abandoned houses, tree removal and access to neighbourhoods for vehicles and pedestrians
2. **February 13:** Mark Van Buren, deputy commissioner, transportation and infrastructure/major projects spoke at a construction forecast event providing an update on upcoming and future planned construction projects for the City of Kingston.
  - Over 100 people attended
  - Mark presented the 2019 capital infrastructure projects, including Third Crossing
