1. October 4, 2018

Meeting with the No Third Crossing Group

- Mayor, Bryan Paterson and Third Crossing City staff met with two members of the No Third Crossing Group to discuss the project, what's next and address any questions

2. October 23, 2018

East side near neighbours community information drop-in meeting about early work activity

- 15-20 people attended
- Presented information about early work activity from fall until end of December 2018

Meeting with Kingston Rowing Club

- Spoke with the club about the project, updates on work activity and to hear their thought and feedback for ideas of the bridge and during construction

- Survey focuses on planned road work and how residents want to be informed about bigger, planned road work projects
