## **EAST SHORE WORK NOTICE**

### **Early work activity on Gore Road and near Kingston Frontenac Public Library (Pittsburgh Branch)**

Starting the week of March 25, 2019, residents can anticipate more site activity on the east shore for the Third Crossing. As discussed at our recent near-neighbour meeting on March 5, 2019 there will be increased early work activity and site presence in March and April, including installing construction safety and environmental protection fencing, delivering site trailers, and select tree removal. Below are the details of the work happening on the east approach.

#### **Periodic lane closures - Point St. Mark Drive from Gore Road (March 25 – 29, 2019)**

- Access to Point St. Mark Drive from Gore Road will have intermittent lane closures for five minute intervals over five days to allow for tree removals from March 25 - March 29, 2019.
- Closures are needed to support some select tree removal and fencing installation
- Workers will be onsite safely directing traffic
- Identified trees are being removed before migratory bird and bat seasons begin
- Pedestrian access to sidewalks will remain open during the work activity
- Pedestrians are asked to refrain from trying to get close to the work activity

#### **Pedestrian pathway periodic closures to community garden and dog park (March 25 – 29, 2019)**

- The pedestrian pathway leading to the community garden and the dog park will be closed for short intervals (roughly five minutes) over five days to allow for equipment to be unloaded.
- Work activity from will run from March 25 until March 29, 2019.
- Workers will be onsite to help direct residents and visitors.

We appreciate your patience as we start to have more site presence on both the east and west approaches. As work continues we want to ensure we have good communications with near neighbours.
