NOTIFICATION OF UTILITY WORK

Dear Residents,

As part of our early works for the Third Crossing, the project team is installing a noise wall on the west side. The noise wall will be a permanent fence that will act as noise mitigation for the project.

In effort to prepare the installation of the west side noise wall along John Counter Boulevard property line, the project team will need to conduct some utility work on private property. The project team will need to enter the below properties in order to do the utility work. Crews will begin work after June 2nd and be ongoing for a few weeks.

Third Crossing crews (2-3 people) will be entering properties along the following Newmarket Lane houses:

- 806, 804, 802, 800, 798, 796, 794, 792, 790, 788, 786, 784, 782, 780 and 778

As this work is necessary for the project and the installation of the noise walls:

- work will be conducted near the property line with utility crews entering private resident properties when necessary
- crews will be conducting work during work hours 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday
- some noise will occur from truck work, pressure washer and hydro excavation operations
- crews will not leave any open holes and the excavated area will be backfilled prior to end of each day. Grass will be planted covering the holes once work has finished.
- supervision will be present at all times
